MODEL MAKING COMPETITION INSTRUCTIONS

- 1) Each team should comprise of 02 students (max) and 01 teacher from each institution.
- 2) Only two students & one coordinating teacher are allowed to present the model.
- 3) One model from each school will be included in competition.
- 4) Maximum Dimensions of the model are length = 2 ft., width = 2 ft., height = 5 ft.
- 5) Theme of the competition is “Exploring Mars, Discovering Earth”
- 6) Models should be placed on the designated venue at least 2-3 hrs before the event
- 7) The space available is for 20 institutions only, based on first come first serve basis.
- 8) Students along with models & coordinating teachers must reach venue well before time.
- 9) Model size limitation must be strictly followed.
- 10) In case of electricity requirement, PI intimates the contact person.

POSTER MAKING COMPETITION INSTRUCTIONS

Drawing / Painting Rules

- 1) Drawing / painting must be on paper of A3 size (297 x 420 mm) or A2 size (420 x 594 mm).
- 2) Acceptable tools of drawing / painting include pencil, crayon, water color, oil paint, computer drawing, etc. Photographs, wires, and other 3D objects are not acceptable. The completed artwork must be on a flat piece of paper.
- 3) The drawing / painting must not include words, national flags, or slogans.
- 4) The drawing / painting must not represent any particular individual, organization, or brand name and must not depict any religious theme.
- 5) Name and age of participant as well as institution name and address must be clearly mentioned on the back of poster in the English Language.
- 6) The theme " Exploring Mars, Discovering Earth " should be the main focus of the poster.
- 7) No text (including theme title, name, etc) should be written on the front of the poster.

General Rules

- 1) Entry submission form should be submitted along with the poster. Form is appended below.
- 2) Each institution can submit up to three posters, of which one poster would be selected by SUPARCO for competition.
- 3) A poster should be an individual effort of a child.
- 4) All posters submitted for competition shall become the property of SUPARCO.
- 5) Winning posters may be sent for international poster competition.

DECLAMATION CONTEST INSTRUCTIONS

- 1) Competition shall be bilingual i.e. in Urdu and English languages.
- 2) Theme for the competition is “Exploring Mars, Discovering Earth”
- 3) Students of Class 8, 9 and 10; intermediate / 1st or 3rd Semesters UET / University are eligible to participate in this competition.
- 4) One student can participate from one institution for each category (English & Urdu).
- 5) Time allowed for speech shall be 7 minutes, after which first bell will ring. Another 30 seconds will be allowed to the speaker to wind-up the speech. After which one mark shall be deducted for every 10 seconds.
- 6) Registration for participating students shall be done on first come first serve basis. A total of 20 students will be selected in each category (English & Urdu) after which the registration process will be closed.

Speech Guidelines

- 1) Content of the speech should be relevant to the title of the contest.
- 2) Speak at normal volume, but clearly and distinctly.
- 3) Avoid hyperbole, verbosity and high sounding words. The tone and language should be relevant to the audience.
- 4) Speech should convey a sense of enthusiasm for the subject.
- 5) Occasionally alter the speed, volume and tone of your delivery. Speaking slower or faster and quieter or louder and being more cheerful or more serious.
- 6) Regularly sweep your eyes left-centre-right and back and front-middle-rear and back, so that you engage all members of your audience.
- 7) You should speak such that you communicate with the audience.
- 8) It is good to use your hands expressively – but do not wave your arms around.
- 9) Always take care of the allotted time and divide judiciously the allotted time of five minutes to all parts of your speech.
- 10) Inappropriate, abusive or slang language, or offensive remarks against any political party/sect etc. shall be not tolerated.

QUIZ COMPETITION INSTRUCTIONS

- 1) A team shall comprise only 2 students from each institution.
- 2) Students of class 9th and 10th; intermediate / 1st or 3rd Semesters UET / University standards can participate in the competition.
- 3) Maximum of 3 participants and 2 accompanying teachers from each institution shall be allowed due to limited seating capacity in the auditorium.

Quiz format:

- 1) Questions shall be asked from the "Space Information Booklet" which has been uploaded on SUPARCO website.
- 2) 60% Questions shall be asked from the "Space Information Booklet" and 40% questions shall be from sources other than the booklet.
- 3) Multiple Choice Questions with four options will be asked.
- 4) Rules shall be read out before each round.
- 5) Answer should be given only after the question options have been read out.
- 6) Correct answer shall only be accepted if answered within the given time limit (before the buzzer rings).
- 7) Questions shall be asked twice.
- 8) All questions are to be answered except in the Tie Breaker.
- 9) Teams shall stand Fail if it
 - a. fails to come on the competition day
 - b. fails to abide the timings of the competition.
 - c. fails to answer any of the questions in the 1st round
 - d. fails to abide by the rules and challenge the judges' decision.
