Solar conditions are at moderate levels with background X-ray flux at C-class level.

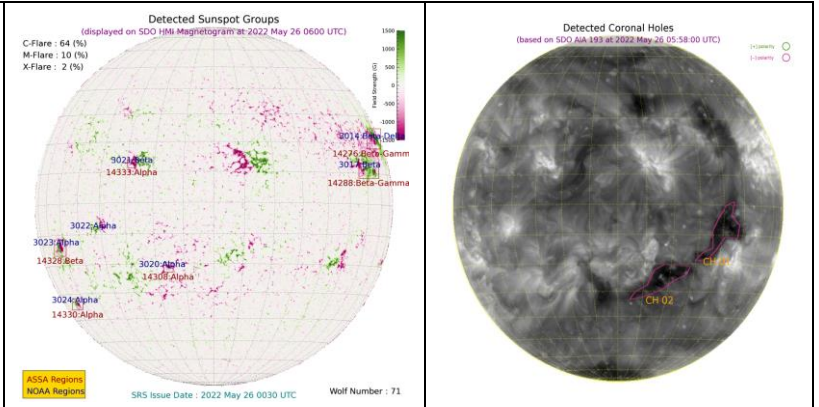

Daily Sun: 26 May 2022

There is one active region AR3014 present on the Sun capable of producing strong C and M-Class solar flares having chances of 64% and 10% respectively.

02 Coronal Holes (CHs) are detected on the solar disk.



DISCUSSION:

Solar activity is expected to remain at moderate levels. Low solar wind speed and quiet geomagnetic activity is expected. Local HF conditions are slightly depressed. Minor radio blackouts may be observed in case of solar flares.
