





There are two active regions AR3280 and AR3281 present on the Sun capable of producing strong M and X-class solar flares having chances of 23% and 2% respectively.

01 Coronal Hole (CH) is detected on the solar disk.





DISCUSSION:

Solar activity is expected to be at low to moderate levels. In case of solar flares, shortwave fadeouts may be observed. Low to slightly elevated solar wind speed is expected due to the presence of coronal holes. Geomagnetic activity is expected to be quiet. HF conditions are slightly enhanced.
