





Daily Sun: 24 July 2023

There is one active region AR3379 present on the Sun capable of producing strong M and X-class solar flares having chances of 85% and 16% respectively.

No Coronal Hole (CH) is detected on the solar disk.





DISCUSSION:

Solar activity is expected to be at low to moderate levels. In case of solar flares, shortwave fadeouts may be observed. Low solar wind speed and quiet geomagnetic activity is expected. HF conditions are normal.
