





There is one active region AR3380 present on the Sun capable of producing strong C and M-class solar flares having chances of 82% and 22% respectively.

01 Coronal Hole (CH) is detected on the solar disk.





DISCUSSION:

Solar activity is expected to be at moderate levels. In case of solar flares, shortwave fadeouts may be observed. Low solar wind speed and quiet geomagnetic activity is expected. HF conditions are normal.
